

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SYNOPSIS

Georgia, 1991.

When Nemo, the estranged father of 12-year-old Toma, reappears after a decade in prison, the two embark on a tense hunting trip meant to rebuild the bond they never had. As Nemo teaches Toma about survival, responsibility, and the truth behind his violent past, their fragile connection finally begins to take shape — until a tragic accident leaves Toma alone in the mountains.

Forced to battle the elements and predators, Toma undertakes a harrowing descent. His return to the city reveals a transformed boy - one who now carries the resilience, independence, and quiet strength of the father he lost just as he found him.

Lorsque Nemo, le père éloigné de Toma, âgé de 12 ans, réapparaît après une décennie de prison, tous deux entreprennent un voyage de chasse tendu destiné à reconstruire le lien qu'ils n'ont jamais eu. Alors que Nemo enseigne à Toma la survie, la responsabilité et la vérité derrière son passé violent, leur connexion fragile commence enfin à se dessiner — jusqu'à ce qu'un tragique accident laisse Toma seul dans les montagnes.

Forcé d'affronter les éléments et les prédateurs, Toma entreprend une descente éprouvante. Son retour en ville révèle un garçon transformé — quelqu'un qui porte désormais la résilience, l'indépendance et la force tranquille du père qu'il a perdu au moment même où il venait de le retrouver.

ABOUT THE FILM

Father and son test the boundaries of trust, loyalty and love on the eve of a pivotal event.

The emotionally charged, intense drama is set against the meticulous recreation of the pivotal year of 1991, when Sakartvelo reclaimed its independence. The air is filled with a thirst for revenge, treachery and merciless threats. Only the whispers of mythical fantasies suggest that this is not a historical film. The mountains are an ocean of angels. The men of the Moon live there. Nobody can kill the Moon.

Director George Ovashvili drew inspiration from his childhood to shape the precisely sketched story throughout production. As in his acclaimed debut "The Other Bank", he cast a boy whom he happened to see in a village. Giorgi Gigauri delivers a marvellous performance, captured in the stunning valleys, mountains and paths of Georgia.

The film had its World Premiere at the 29th Black Nights festival in Tallinn (PÖFF29) on the 20th of November 2025.



DIRECTOR'S BIOGRAPHY

George Ovashvili (1963) is a graduate from the film department of the Georgian State Institute of Cinema and Theatre (1996) and the course of filmmaking of The New York Film Academy of Universal Studio in Hollywood (2006).

His first feature film, "The Other Bank" (2009) premiered at the Berlin International Film Festival in 2009 and won over 50 international prizes.




His second feature "Corn Island" (2014) won the Crystal Globe at Karlovy Vary International Film Festival 2014 and was shortlisted for the Academy Awards's best foreign language film in 2015. After having produced his own works, George started a film production company, Wagonnet Film, in Tbilisi, Georgia, in 2016. The company aims to produce various talented directors' works, mainly through international co-production.

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PRODUCER'S BIOGRAPHY

Fabrizio Maltese is an Italian-Luxembourger documentary filmmaker and producer, with a background in award-winning photography. Over the past decade, he has established a distinctive voice in creative documentary, working as a director, cinematographer, and producer on his own films.

Since 2015, he has directed and produced five feature-length documentaries, including *Twenty-Five Palms*, *California Dreaming*, *I fiori persi* (Lost Flowers), and *The Invitation*, which premiered at major international, Oscar-qualifying festivals such as Thessaloniki, Morelia, Transilvania, and Tallinn Black Nights. His cinematic work is marked by a strong visual identity and a deep engagement with intimate, author-driven narratives.

Alongside his directing career, Fabrizio has increasingly focused on creative producing. In 2018, he founded the Luxembourg-based production company **Joli Rideau Media**, which embraces a boutique approach and an affinity for bold, cross-genre storytelling. The company supports both emerging and established filmmakers across creative documentary and select arthouse fiction.

Joli Rideau Media is currently involved in several international co-productions, including Afonso's Smile by João Pedro Rodrigues and Re-Creation by Jim Sheridan and David Merriman.

Fabrizio has served as a jury member at major international film festivals such as Black Nights (Tallinn), Istanbul, and Thessaloniki. He has participated in leading industry programs including IDFA Producers Connection, Eurodoc, the Rotterdam Lab, Jihlava's Emerging Producers, and DFI's Qumra. He is a voting member of the European Film Academy and of Luxembourg's producers guild, ULPA.



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
